

Ensure Access



- •Utilize community resources Partner with agencies to reach and support English Learners (ELs) and their families
- •Schedule on-site opportunities for students and families during traditional school hours, virtual sessions during evenings and weekends, and pop-up outdoor sessions in safe and accessible locations
 - Gather data from exit surveys to assess additional needs for re-attendees
- •Strengthen the use of language interpretation services
- Complete home visits
- Create videos in Spanish (and other languages if needed)
- Provide Family Engagement and Cultural Climate staff training



More Outreach



- •Offer a variety of opportunities to encourage student, parent and family engagement.
- Schedule parent and family workshops
- Complete physical and virtual home visits
- Collaborate with colleagues to identify and address unforeseen barriers
- •Facilitate community forums use creative themes
