- Attendance approach = MTSS






Role of the McKinney-Vento Liaison

<u>Formally</u>: Identify students experiencing homelessness and ensure protections under the law (immediate enrollment, free lunch, transportation assistance, access to resources)

<u>Informally</u>: we connect with families in transition, we build relationships and those relationships can lead to better attendance

Arguably this population is the most "at-risk"







12% of all MCPS students were chronically absent

29% of MCPS student experiencing homelessness were chronically absent

- phone numbers and addresses
- family's story
- members of the families support team
- interrelationships between various families

HOW I CAN HELP



- Save school staff time
- **get in touch** with family
- community outreach and resources

 feel understood this can lead to increased compliance
- district-level data analysis
- Providing additional Information
- creative problem solving
