# TYPES OF BULLYING

## PHYSICAL BULLYING

Intentionally damaging someone's reputation or their relationships. This includes repeated: Lying or spreading rumors, leaving someone out on purpose, telling others not to be friends with someone, embarrassing someone in public.

## CYBER BULLYING

Using technology (a computer, phone, tablet, video game) to intentionally hurt someone through social or verbal bullying behaviors.
