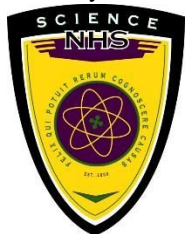
Dear Sir or Madam:

Each year we have approximately 200 students present their Science Fair projects within a variety of categories, and consequently we require a large number of judges. Science Fair judges should have an interest and basic knowledge in biology, chemistry, and physics, as the majority of the student projects will focus around these topics. Previous experience as a judge is not needed, but do not worry, support materials will be provided to make the judging process easy. We ask that judges arrive at Mount Vernon High School between 8:00 - 8:30 am on Tuesday, February 5. Judges will review and listen to presentations for about 8-9 student projects. Judging is typically completed by 12:00 pm.
