VIP ADDITIONAL DETAILS

Eligibility, Registration, Waitlist: This program is designed for rising middle school age youth. Children who are residents of Fairfax County or Fairfax City, and are **rising 7th grade and 8th grade (entering fall of 2019)**, are invited to participate. Individuals are encouraged to register early. There is a possibility that students will be placed on a waitlist once the program meets its maximum capacity. The program has a fee of **\$50.00 (\$25.00 with a variance)** which will cover the cost for a field trip, including the bus fee. The field trips planned for VIP are:

- **National Zoo/World Gate Movies/Water Park**

Staffing for VIP: VIP camps are staffed by the FCPS After-School Program Specialists (ASPS), Fairfax County Department of Neighborhood and Community Services (NCS) staff, and other county agencies.

Breakfast/Lunch: Breakfast and lunch will be provided to all students at no additional cost.

Transportation: In the morning, school buses will pick up VIP campers from select elementary schools, middle schools and community locations and transport them to Carson MS. In the evening, school buses will return students from Carson MS to select elementary schools and community locations. **Detailed information is not yet available. This will be provided as soon as FCPS Transportation Services finalizes route information.**

Sub Camp Descriptions

Sub Camps will be held during the morning portion of each day.

After lunch, students will have multiple electives to choose from daily. Specific electives are TBD.

Basketball Nation will provide students with basketball skills that will excel their game for the upcoming school year. Students will be equipped with basketball knowledge from former collegiate athletes and coaches. There will be many opportunities for competition through drills, scrimmages and tournaments!

Soccer Academy is for the student who loves soccer. They will improve their individual and team skills with training by soccer players and coaches.

STEAM (*Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math*) will challenge our student's knowledge and creativity. Our main focus will be engineering and technology. Students will be introduced to different areas of engineering and gain knowledge in coding, HTML website, and other miscellaneous topics.

SCIENCE & PROGRAMMING *will provide students an exciting opportunity to explore areas of science such as physics, learn some basic programming, and work with Arduino's.*

Theater In Action will be provided with a survey of Theatre Arts by actively allowing students to participate in the creative process of performance and production. Students will improve communication skills that target different learning styles while still having an awesome and fun time together. Most importantly, teens will perform, create, investigate and connect with their peers.

Cooking will provide students with an opportunity to explore the secrets of cooking and receive valuable insights into the culinary arts.
