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Credit Recovery for Algebra or Geometry	7/6-7/24 Sign up by 6/12	Students who passed or failed Algebra 1 may take the Virtual Credit Recovery course to improve their understanding and skills before the next school year. Students who participate will meet daily with high school staff, review Algebra content, and receive a grade at the end of the summer. Students currently in the 7th or 8th grade should work with their counselor in deciding to expunge one of the passing Algebra 1 course grades. High school credit bearing course work taken during the summer between the 8th and 9th grade may not be expunged. Any student can sign up for Credit Recovery, teachers and schools may also invite students to attend.
