Minecraft	<i>Test your Minecraft skills and programming abilities with friends having the support of staff as you work through strategies and sharing achievements.</i>
Photography	<i>Learn the art of photography with fun activities you can do in the comfort of your own home. We will test your eye and editing skills doing activities based on themes to introduce a little excitement every week. Enter your best photos in the virtual fair at the end of the program.</i>
Soccer	<i>Love to play soccer and want to improve your skills. Join this program for weekly skill challenges, instructions, coaching, and team discussions each week.</i>
STEM/4-H Club	<i>Students will the concepts of science and ecology. We will be doing experiments with items you can find around your house and going on virtual exploration of our gardens and around our communities. We will do a 5-week challenge and hold a virtual 4-H fair.</i>
Technology	<i>Asynchronous activities will be provided throughout camp by the Fairfax County Computer Clubhouse team of experts. Lessons in video editing, web design, coding and more.</i>
Theatre	<i>Improv intensified, we will build a strong sense of community through theatre games and scene work. Participants will explore concepts of characterization, collaboration, and storytelling by working through the lens of improvised acting.
