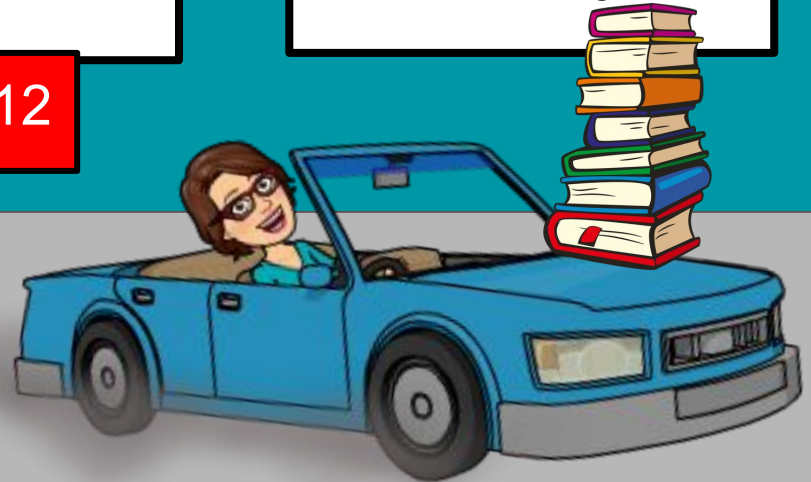

Curbside Checkout Instructions

1. Put up to **5** books on hold with the **Destiny Online Catalog** <https://bit.ly/3gvOA2t> . Watch this [video](#) or read these [instructions](#) to learn more.
TIP: Be sure to put books marked IN on hold to be sure you check out each week!
2. In addition to print books, the library has a wide selection of **ebooks and audiobooks** that can be checked out online to read or listen to. See [here](#) for instructions on how to access. Many **databases** also contain ebooks. See [here](#) for instructions on how to access.
3. Books will be pulled and checked out each week. You will receive an **email notification** when books are ready. Please disregard any pop up notices that inform you that books must be picked up right away.
4. Books can be picked up on **Mondays from 10 - 12**. Drive to Door 9 with student last name displayed in your window. Books will be placed on a table for you to pick up. Books may be returned at this time as well. Walkers must wear masks and maintain 6 feet of distance from others. Contact Mrs. Scherbenske if you are unable to pick up books during the 10 - 12 window..
