

Driver's Ed and Licensing Information

DEC-8 (PINK CARD) Pick up

Monday February 8th from 8am – 12pm or from 3pm – 5pm, current HPE10 students who have PASSED Driver's Ed this school year are invited to "Drive-through" and pick up their PINK CARD. We will be distributing them outside of Entrance #5 (Academy Entrance). No need to get out of your car, simply stay along the curb, drive by and we will hand you your card. Your last name written large in sharpie on an 8x11 piece of paper may help to speed the process. It is suggested you enter school grounds from the light, turn left past the front of the school, then right as you head towards Entrance #5. This will allow traffic to flow easily around the building. Please avoid turning around or making U-turns.

LEARNER'S PERMIT TESTING

We know that getting an appointment at the DMV is rather difficult right now. FCPS Adult and Community Education is currently holding Learner's Permit Testing at Pimmit Hills. If you are in need, and eligible to get a Learner's Permit test and cannot get an appointment with the DMV, this is the perfect opportunity. There is a small cost for the test, and you will still need to go to the DMV to get the official hard copy of the permit. BEHIND THE WHEEL CLASS

Students looking for Behind the Wheel classes to complete their Licensing Process can find options at the ACE Registration Website. The Behind the Wheel classes leave from various FCPS high schools and students are welcome to attend ANY BTW class leaving from any school. (You do not have to take a class out of Chantilly HS). There are classes leaving from Westfield, Centreville, Oakton, WT Woodson, Robinson, South Lakes, etc. It is encouraged that students look to the future and estimate when they will be ready and eligible to take the BTW course and sign up as early as possible. All instructors are current or former FPCS teachers, certified by the state and county to follow the VDOE and DMV curriculum, and very familiar with working with teenagers on new skill development. It is recommended that students have at least 20 hours of practice before they attempt to take this class.

REPLACEMENT DEC-8 CARDS

Students who have lost their DEC card and need a replacement can find the Request form (Google Form) on the Chantilly High School Website under Driver's Education OR on the Student Google Site. There is a cost of \$10 for a replacement copy of the card.
