College Information Sessions:

Seniors and juniors who plan to go to college after high school graduation are starting the college admissions process. College admissions representatives are invited to the CCC during the fall to present information about their schools. This year, I will be hosting in-person college representatives in the CCC, unless the college representative decides to conduct their visit virtually. Visits will begin the week of September 13th.

Students will register to attend college visits through **Naviance Student.** The registration process instructs students to print the confirmation page as a "Pass" or take a screen shot on their cell phone to show teacher(s) whose class(es) they will be missing at least 2 days prior to the event.
