What is the WordMasters Challenge?

The WordMasters Challenge™ is a national competition for students that encourages growth in vocabulary and verbal reasoning. Unlike other language arts competitions – which focus on grammar, punctuation, spelling and other language mechanics – the WordMasters Challenge™ helps students learn to think both analytically and metaphorically. Excellence in the competition will require both a mastery of the meanings of the vocabulary words (of a difficulty appropriate to each grade level) and thoughtful reasoning about the relationships between these words and more familiar language used in the competition's analogies.
