LONGWOOD On-Site Admissions

This is an opportunity for seniors to receive an admission decision in November.

Nursing students MAY NOT participate in the Longwood on-site program.

If you have already applied to Longwood, and would like to participate in the on-site program, see Mrs. Geary in the Counseling Office by November 15.

1. **APPLY online no later than November 15 at www.longwood.edu or www.commonapp.org**
2. **REQUEST your Transcript from Mrs. Geary in the Counseling Office by November 16**

Longwood Decision Day ~ November 18 beginning at 12:00pm
You will receive an appointment time (be sure to check your SCHOOL EMAIL)
from Mrs. Otto closer to the date.

What Happens During an On-Site Meeting?

Students will receive an appointment time to meet with the admissions representative and will receive an offer or a deferred decision. No one will be denied at this time. If you are deferred, you'll be able to have a conversation with the admissions representative about the additional information they need to make a final decision (typically it's because they want to see additional grades.)

Offer – Congratulations! You have until May 1 to make a final decision about attending.

Defer – You will receive information about the additional steps, material or information that Longwood needs to make a final decision.

Remember:

- ✓ You will receive an appointment time (via your school email)
- ✓ When you enter the Room 110, introduce yourself
- ✓ Dress is casual, nothing formal, but keep in mind this is an important meeting
