

Willow Springs/Spring 2022 Garden/Farm-to-Table Club

The Willow Springs PTA is excited to continue the afterschool Garden/Farm-to-Table Club for your children. Spring club participants will learn how to plan, plant, and harvest a garden of native flowers and vegetables. They will help with the Willow Springs Farmer's Market with local farm partner, Piney Meadow Farm, and learn how to prepare delicious dishes with the seasonal produce. They will learn about garden science, the importance of eating healthy and local, and have fun exploring in nature. They also will learn about Monarch Butterflies (and other pollinators) and work in our Monarch Waystation that was planted spring 2014.

Meetings are Fridays from 4-5:30 p.m., April 15-June 3. Boys and girls in $\frac{3^{rd}}{10^{rd}}$ through 6th grade are eligible to participate. There will be a limit of 20 students for the club this spring. Kids must be picked up from club promptly at 5:30 p.m.
