

Things Students Should Know About AP Exams

- Students should arrive no later than 7:45am for an 8am exam and no later than 11:45am for a 12pm exam
- Afternoon/PM exams may get out as later as 3:30/4pm. Please have a ride home available if necessary.
- Students will not be admitted once exams have been distributed
- If you have 2 exams in one day, be sure to bring extra snacks and lunch. There will be sometime between exams but not enough to sit and eat in the cafeteria. Your food must be in a clear plastic bag under your desk.
- You will not be allowed to access any bags once testing has begun.
- No talking is permitted during the entire exam. Please raise your hand for questions.
- When you are done, please sit quietly without talking. You may not bring anything to read or write while you wait. You are expected to stay seated and be respectful of others testing. Exam disruption may result in dismissal and cancellation of test scores.

What to Bring?

- 2 sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers no cases
- 2 pens with black or dark blue ink no cases
- Up to 2 approved calculators for (AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics, or Statistics approved calculators can be viewed at apstudents.org/calulators.
- A ruler or straightedge only for AP Physics
- Lunch or snack in clear plastic bags
- Water in bottles or sealed containers is permitted under your seat. All drinks must have a lid.



What NOT to Bring?

- Backpacks or purses
- Cases for pencils or pens (Pencils/pens must be in clear bag)
- Electronic equipment including phones, smartwatches, fitness trackers, wearable technology, recording or listening devices, or any other electronic communication device - CELL PHONES
 ARE NOT ALLOWED. Leave in your locker, car, or at home.
- Books, reference guides, notes, compasses, protractors all will be confiscated prior to entering the door
- Paper of any kind



Pre-Arranged Absences for AP Exams

- Students will be allowed to take up to a half-day absence for every AP exam they are taking. Therefore, students may take a half-day absence the morning of an exam day or the afternoon following an exam. This does not apply if you have opted out of the exam.
- A signed, pre-arranged absence form is required for each student.
- You are responsible for material and assignments missed.
- Madison HS Administration strongly recommends that AP students remain in school the entire day on their AP exam days.
- Any student athlete that wishes to participate in a game that night, must be in school all day.
- Forms due no later than Friday, April 29 to the attendance office.
