

So, you want to be an activity driver.....

Qualifications:

- Pre-training: CDL learners permit – you will have to do a written test at the DMV for this
- Pre-training: Copy of DMV driving record
- Pre-training: current physical...once you have been deemed qualified for training, you will be referred to contact Virginia Sellers at Human Resources (HR), 571-423-3104, VESellers@fcps.edu.
- Willingness to drive school bus with athletes to practice/competition
- Available generally beginning around 3:00 PM once the sports seasons start
- Successful completion of paid 40-hour activity driver training course with FCPS (includes road instruction and testing), plus 8 hours of First Aid training and subsequent paid OJT hours
- You must apply through the [online application system](#). Then contact Connie Lovejoy, Human Resources [.calovejoy@fcps.edu](mailto:calovejoy@fcps.edu) 571-423-3023 to identify yourself as a candidate for an activity driver position as opposed to a regular bus driver. She also has detailed information regarding application, hiring and training.

Hours:

- Most critical times are 3:00pm-4:45 PM..... any trip you begin during this time frame you may complete. If more convenient for you, you may take the team only one way and drop them at their location, return the bus to the designated parking location and another bus/driver (from Area Transportation) will bring the team home. Activity drivers may not begin a trip during those times when regular bus drivers are available (to include holidays, teacher workdays, weekends, etc.)

When:

- Each sports season—Fall sports trips begin the first day of school; Winter sports start in November; Spring sports begin in February.
- Activity drivers are needed daily Monday-Friday.

Pay:

- This can vary according to your specific situation. The specifics are addressed by Salary Services.
