Willow Spring's Math Olympiad club resumes its meetings for 5th and 6th grade mathletes. The objectives of the math Olympiad Club are to teach multiple strategies for out-of-the-box problem solving, develop mathematical flexibility in solving those problems, and foster mathematical creativity and ingenuity through challenging competitions.

The club will offer weekly meetings and several competition opportunities.



1. **MOEMS** - MOEMS is one of the most influential and fun-filled math competition programs in the United States and throughout the world, with over 120,000 students from every state and 39 countries participating. Last year Willow Spring ES's team was among top 10% and received a high recognition and Plaque. The competition consists of 5 contests: **5 problems in 30 minutes**.

- 4th Competition Feb 6 – Mar 10
- 5th Competition Mar 6 – Mar 31

2. Perennial Math



Perennial Math Online Competition has 2 seasons to choose from with 4 tests per season - one each month. Season 1 is November through February and Season 2 is January through April. The tests are composed of 6 questions.

3. **Noetic Learning Math Contest**: This is a semiannual problem-solving contest for elementary and middle school students

20 problems in 45 minutes

Competition Dates: Nov 10 – Nov 23, Apr 6 – Apr 20
