Re: Justice High School – Student and Staff Overflow Parking

Dear Neighbors of Justice High School:

Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS), in consultation with the Fairfax County Mason District Supervisor's Office and the Mason District Station of the Fairfax County Police Department, is requesting temporary parking on a portion of Diamond Drive and Peace Valley Lane for the final two months of this school year. FCPS has started construction on the school addition project which has resulted in the loss of some on-site parking for students and staff. While we will work to provide parking on the school site for permitted users, we may need some overflow for the students and staff who leave during the day and return to a full parking lot.

The temporary parking will occur starting on April 10, 2023, through June 16, 2023, Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m.-3:30 p.m., for a maximum of thirty vehicles with permits required at any given time. The temporary parking will be located along the north side of Diamond Drive between Peace Valley Lane and Faragut Court, where there are currently no driveways, and also along the west side of Peace Valley Lane between Diamond Drive and Cheryl Drive between 3258 Peace Valley Lane and 6201 Cheryl Drive, within the Residential Permit Parking District (RPPD). These vehicles must display a FCPS hangtag parking pass while parked within the RPPD in the noted locations. No one from the school will be permitted to park in the RPPD during the summer break or beyond June 16, 2023.
