Donation of Your Student's Epinephrine

Did you know that you can donate your student's epinephrine to someone in need at the end of the school year? Medication left in the health room after dismissal on the last day is discarded if it is not picked up. Instead of discarding it, consider donating! Donating your student's epinephrine is voluntary.

Your Choice May Save a Life

By giving your permission to the Fairfax County Health Department to act as your agent, you allow us to donate the epinephrine to someone in need. If you would like us to donate it, sign the permission on the reverse side of this card and return it to the school health room. We will only donate epinephrine with an expiration date that is not less than 90 days from the date the drug is donated at the end of the school year. All student identifiers will be removed.

A registered drug donation site may receive eligible donated drugs, transfer such donated drugs to another registered drug donation site, or redispense the donated drugs in accordance with § 54.1-3411.1 of the Code of Virginia to patients of clinics organized in whole or in part for the delivery of health care services to the indigent.
