Schedule Changes

Middle School

- Inaccurate placement by grade or course level, including Honors courses.

Specific teacher requests or requests for a different teacher are not granted.

High School

High School counselors will be available in Davala Hall to discuss scheduling errors only. Requests for schedule changes at this time will only be honored based on the following criteria:

- Student does not have a complete schedule or is missing a core class required for graduation
- Student is placed in a course different from what was requested or recommended.
- Schedule does not reflect summer school courses that were successfully passed.
