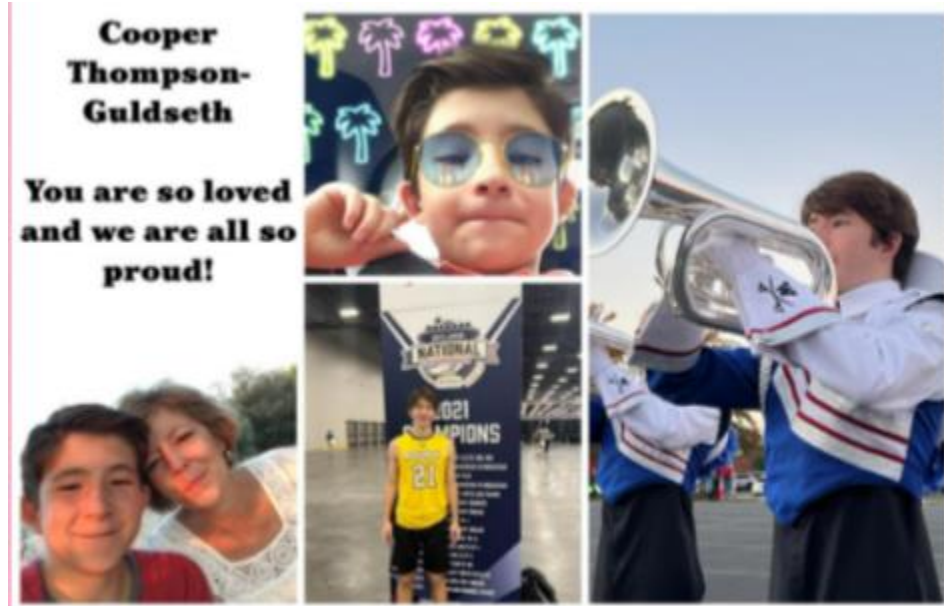

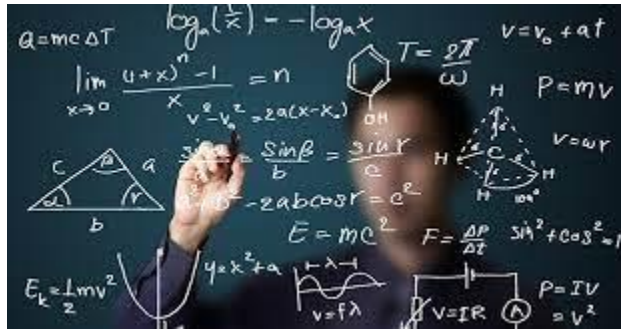

Attendance

Attendance is critical to student success in the classroom.

If your student will be absent from school, a parent/guardian must notify the [attendance office](#).

Parents/guardians must contact the attendance office (703-503-4800) to report attendance; **emails and online forms will no longer be accepted to notify our school of your student's absence.** Woodson is not monitoring or accepting any absences submitted via email. Due to an excessive number of forgeries, the online attendance form is currently disabled.

Below is a quick guide for reporting all-day absences, late arrivals, and early check-outs from school.

All Day Absence

- Notify the attendance office by calling 703-503-4800 and leave a message on option 1 for all day absence
- OR - student brings a parent or doctor note to the attendance office upon arrival to school the next day (within 3 days of absence)
- Please realize your student will be marked as Unverified until the attendance office hears from you

Check-in procedure: Between 8:10 AM and 8:30 AM

Excused (with valid reason) - go to attendance office E107 for a pass to class

Unexcused (without valid reason) - go directly to class

Check-in procedure: After 8:30 (all students excused or unexcused)

First- notify the attendance office of late arrival by calling 703-503-4800 or sending a note with the student

Next- upon arrival to school, student **must** go to the attendance office to check-in

Last- student receives a pass to class, student goes to class

* Due to staff responsibilities, we are not able to guarantee timely, unannounced early checkouts. Please be aware that if you make a last-minute appointment it may take up to 30 minutes to retrieve your student from class. This includes the end of the school day.

Early Release Send in a note that includes:

- Student name and ID#
- Date and time (this is the time student will be released from class)
- Reason for early release
- Parent name, signature, and phone number

Student must take the note to E107 before school

Please be advised that phone calls for early check-out will be accepted **only** in cases of emergency. A parent will still need to come into the building.

Check-out procedure: *

First- Parent writes a note containing all information listed above

Next- upon arrival to school, student takes their parent written early release note to E107 and receives a pink check-out pass

Then- at check-out time on pass, student shows pass to their teacher and student leaves class

Last- student returns to attendance office with pink check-out pass to complete checkout

Failure to follow this procedure may result in an untimely check-out

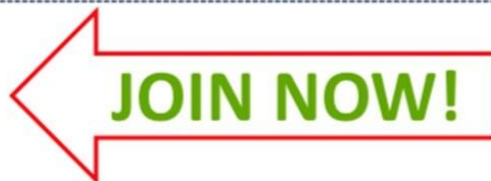
