PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

TUESDAY (8 weeks)

<p>FLOOR HOCKEY Baroodly Camps 4th-6th \$155</p>	<p>Floor hockey is an action packed game where boys and girls move constantly. Kids will learn the basics of hockey in a safe, age appropriate environment and will learn to compete as a team with high effort and sportsmanship in each session. Each day will end with full games, but will begin with lead-up games and skill building to help them hone skills that translate across all sports.</p>
<p>AFRICAN SAFARI DRAWING Young Rembrandts K-6th \$228</p>	<p>Go on a Safari adventure with Young Rembrandts this spring semester! We will explore the exciting land and many animals that inhabit Africa. To keep things exciting, we will explore the African Safari through the fun technique of Young Rembrandts. Our exploration through Africa allows for a bounty of adventure and creativity.</p>
<p>LEGO WEDO JURASSIC BOTS Baroodly Camps 4th-6th \$210</p>	<p>Journey back in time with Lego WeDo 2.0: Jurassic! In this course, children will have the opportunity to explore the prehistoric world of dinosaurs as they build and program their own robots. Starting with a base robot model, children will use their creativity and problem-solving skills to transform their models into a variety of dinosaur-themed robots. This course is designed to give children a challenge where critical thinking and inference will be emphasized. This will provide students with the opportunity to apply their STEM and computer science skills to control their dinosaur creations!</p>

WEDNESDAY (9 weeks)

<p>FLOOR HOCKEY Baroodly Camps 1st-3rd \$170</p>	<p>Floor hockey is an action packed game where boys and girls move constantly. Kids will learn the basics of hockey in a safe, age appropriate environment and will learn to compete as a team with high effort and sportsmanship in each session. Each day will end with full games, but will begin with lead-up games and skill building to help them hone skills that translate across all sports.</p>
<p>SCRATCH CODING AND GAME DESIGN Cyberteck Academy 4th-6th \$258</p>	<p>In this course students will learn basic programming and logic flow and learn how to apply those concepts to create games. Using Scratch, a scripting language developed by MIT to give kids an easy entry into coding, students will go through the iterative process of creating a program or game from idea to completion. Successful students in this class will have several completed 2D games they will be able to play and show off on most computers and will have mastered the skills they need to continue making games using scratch at home.</p>
<p>MUSICAL THEATRE Message in Motion 1st-6th \$285</p>	<p>Students will learn the meaning of a triple threat performer in this class that introduces the main components of musical theatre including voice, acting, basic music theory, and dance technique (typically musical theatre jazz/broadway style and/or hip hop.) Learn choreography and staging basics while utilizing props, role playing, and imagination to aid in personal expression and creativity! Students will learn and collaborate on mini musical routines from both old school Broadway shows like Cats and Mary Poppins, to more contemporary productions and shows like Hamilton, Annie, Lion King, and more! Students will showcase what they have learned at an informal end of session in class parent show! Pending School Approval. What to wear: Comfy clothing, (easy to move around in), with sneakers and socks. Preferably no khakis, dresses, skirts, or jeans on class days. Hair pulled back.</p>

THURSDAY (8 weeks)

<p>CHESS Magnus Chess Academy 1st-6th \$228</p>	<p>Learn chess with Magnus Academy (formerly Silver Knights), world champion Magnus Carlsen's academy! We've taught 100,000 children to play including state & national champions, but most students are beginners looking to learn a new skill and have FUN. Class time is divided between lessons and practice games. Lessons range from the basic rules to advanced tournament strategies. Students will have the opportunity to play in tournaments (in-person and online) outside of club time. This in-person club includes free online extras including weekly practice tournaments and an event with world champion Magnus Carlsen or Judit Polgar, the best female chess player of all time. <p>HIP HOP DANCE Kids in Motion K-6th \$198</p>	<p>Kids in Motion Hip Hop class is a high energy, exciting dance fitness class specifically designed for children. Classes are set up with kid friendly hip hop music, movements, and routines. In addition to a dance workout, they will also play games such as freeze dance, dancing 4 corners, limbo, center star, follow the leader, balloon games, limbo, and many more. Hip Hop Dance is a great fit for children and it creates an environment of excitement around being healthy and active! Instructors are certified Zumba Kids instructors through Zumba International, which certifies them to teach 4-12 year old children, or they are experienced Hip Hop/Dance instructors. All instructors receive further training through Kids in Motion lead dance instructors.</p>
<p>LEGO SPIKE ESSENTIAL ROBOTICS: GREAT ADVENTURES Baroodly Camps 1st-3rd \$210</p>	<p>In this program, children will be introduced to computational thinking. They'll begin to understand what a sequence is, be able to follow instructions to create a sequence, and describe the sequence to their peers. They'll learn how to break problems down into smaller parts, identify cause and effect, and understand simple loops. Finally, they'll explore the process of testing and debugging programs to ensure that their programs work as intended. Children will find ways of helping the main characters, and practice recounting an experience using relevant details, which will help to develop their collaborative conversation skills.</p>
