
## LCES Presents... One School, One Book

If you choose to participate, your family will receive a copy of *A Boy Called Bat*, a sweet story that teaches us how to be perceptive, patient, and accepting. Along with the book, a nightly reading schedule will be sent home for your convenience. The program recommends approximately 15 minutes of reading each evening. **Please feel free to research this title prior to your family's** participation in the program!

One School, One Book is a reading program in which children from kindergarten through sixth grade listen to their parents read aloud the same book. We have selected a title that can be understood and enjoyed by younger students, while still stimulating the minds of older children. Everyone in the LCES community— students, parents, teachers, and administrators will delight in reading this engaging tale!

In school, students will be invited to answer trivia questions to encourage active listening. You will soon find that your child will take pride in knowing and anticipating the details of the story. Throughout the course of the program, students will explore the book through activities and discussion in their classroom.
