Week of March 18 through June 1

League	Description
Majors	One practice, one weeknight game, one Saturday game. Unique to Cal Ripken, our upper tier for our most experienced players introduces 70 foot base paths and a 50 foot pitching distance, leads and steals for base runners, pickoffs and balks for pitchers.
Minors	One practice, one weeknight game, one Saturday game. The minors are geared for players who can demonstrate fundamental throwing, fielding, and hitting skills, but are still learning to apply them at game speed.
Machine Pitch	One practice, one weeknight game, one Saturday game. A player's first experience with an umpire. As one of our best offerings, players often spend 2-3 seasons in Machine Pitch depending on skill level. Typically 7-8 year olds.
Coach Pitch	One practice, one Saturday game. For players who demonstrate all of the tee ball skills. Coaches serve as the pitcher using a soft leather ball. Typically 5-7 year olds.
Tee Ball	One practice, one Saturday game. Players hit from a tee, and begin to learn the fundamentals of hitting, throwing and catching. Focus is on enjoyment of the game. Typically 4-6 year olds.
Blastball	A 30 min practice followed by a 30 min game on Saturday. A Guardian-and-Me experience and a great introduction to baseball for 3-4 year olds.
Buddy Ball	One practice/game on Sunday mornings. Buddy Ball pairs players with disabilities and a high school buddy to have fun, build confidence and self-esteem, and learn sportsmanship and love of the game.
