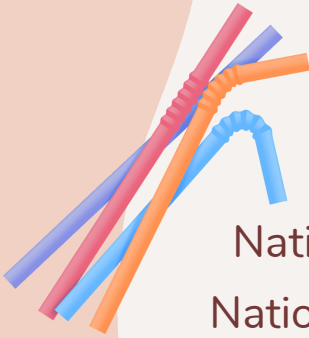

April 15 is right around the corner! If you need help preparing your tax return, there are free resources available to assist you.

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)

If you or your family earned less than \$64,000 in 2023, you may qualify for this free service! The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program is a national program sponsored by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) that helps income-eligible families maximize their tax returns and avoid the fees businesses charge to prepare taxes. Since 2008, Fairfax County Department of Family Services has provided operational support to coalition partners processing tax returns, bringing back over \$100 Million in refunds to the Northern Virginia Community. In-person VITA services are available at several sites in Northern Virginia. Walk-ins are welcome, no appointments are needed. 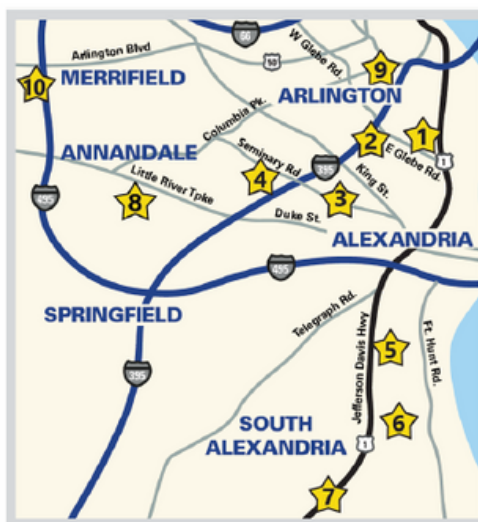

Activity Facilitator

Recreation Leader II (Part-Time, Non-Merit, up to \$17.00 per hour)
Recreation Leader III (Part-Time, Non-Merit, up to \$19.00 per hour)

Responsibilities: Plans, prepares, and leads community center activities. Provides leadership and ensures the safety of all center participants. Assists in marketing of programs and outreach to the community. Work 17 hours a week; must be available to work days, nights and weekend schedules as needed.

Minimum Qualifications: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to high school graduation or GED. Experience working with youth, teens, adults, seniors and/or families. Must be 18 years of age; and 21 years of age for positions working with teens.

Preferred Qualifications: Previous experience working with community recreational programs serving youth, teens, adults, seniors and/or families. Ability to drive a 14-passenger (non-CDL) bus. Bilingual in English and a second language.

Day Care Center Teacher 1

(Part-Time, Benefits Eligible, \$20.91 per hour)

Responsibilities: Plans, prepares and carries out activities and projects for groups of elementary school-age children enrolled in a before and after-school program. Provides leadership and ensures the safety of the children enrolled in the center. Work mornings, afternoons and evenings, 30 hours per week, Monday thru Friday for 40 weeks.

Minimum Qualifications: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to completion of two years of study and training at an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in early childhood or elementary education, nursing, recreation or a related field plus one year of related work experience.

Preferred Qualifications: Major course work in early childhood education. Experience working with groups of children. Bilingual ability.

Day Care Center Assistant Teacher

(Part-Time, Non-Merit, \$18.15 per hour)

Responsibilities: Plans, prepares, and carries out activities and projects for groups of elementary school-age children enrolled in a before and after-school program. Ensures the safety of the children enrolled in the center. Must be available to work 4 days per week including Mondays and Fridays from 2:15 - 6:15 p.m. Morning hours are also available between 7 - 9:30 a.m. Occasional flexible work hours and full days required. Required to travel to various locations within Fairfax County using own transportation.

Minimum Qualifications: Reliable and enthusiastic about working with children.

Preferred Qualifications: Experience working with school age children in a child care program, camp, recreation, or similar setting.
