



Camp Fairfax

Select public schools and community centers across Fairfax County welcome rising 1st through 7th graders for a weekly summer camp. Campers enjoy exciting opportunities in outdoor adventures, performing arts, sports and recreation, visual arts, science, technology, engineering and math exploration and much more. Registration opens in March.

Sully Community Center Sports & More Camp

A partnership between NCS and the Fairfax County Park Authority offers affordable summer camps at Sully Community Center. Eligible families will pay reduced rates for children to participate in popular Park Authority summer camps. Registration opens in January.

Teens in Action

Teens in Action offers an engaging, healthy and affordable recreation program for Youth ages 12 to 18 to learn, play and serve. Locations across Fairfax County. Registration opens in March.

Therapeutic Recreation Camps

NCS'Therapeutic Recreation offers affordable summer camp experiences for individuals (ages 5-22) with developmental disabilities, intellectual disabilities, autism spectrum disorder, physical disabilities, emotional disabilities, learning disabilities, and/or attention deficit disorders. Camp registration opens in April.

Value in Prevention (V.I.P.) Camps

Sponsored by Fairfax County Public Schools and NCS, V.I.P. summer camp encourages current or rising middle school students to develop healthy and positive recreation interests through a wide variety of leisure activities and programs. Registration opens in March.

4-H Camps

Fairfax County's overnight 4-H camp is held at the Northern Virginia 4-H Center for campers ages 9-13; high schoolers may also become counselors. The five-day, four-night camp is offered for one week in July. Registration opens by January.


