To receive prizes for completing the Adventure, bring this log to any FCPL branch.

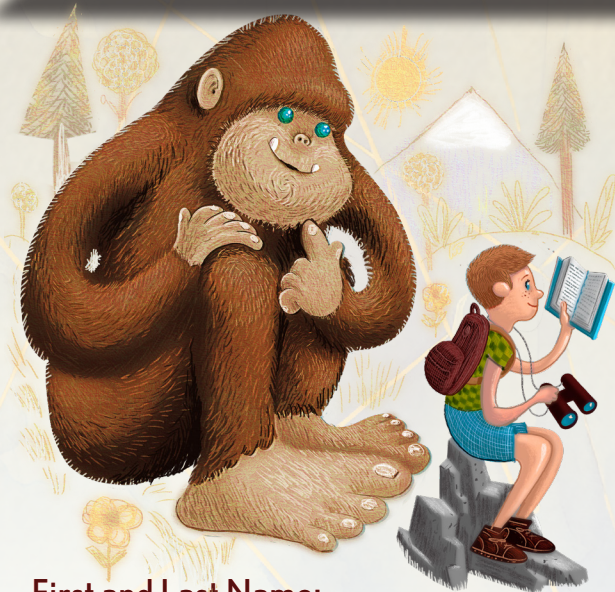
