Special **LEAP** account:

As an FCPS student, you can now check out up to 3 public library books at a time for six weeks each (no renewals) **WITHOUT an FCPL library card**: just give your name. **No fines or fees ever!**

You can also have a regular FCPL account (so you can place holds on books, access ebooks, etc.) Have a parent **click here** if you do not yet have an FCPL library card for a regular FCPL account.

Finding books and other things (print and electronic) for reading on your own, year-round

Instructions for logging into the <u>ATES library catalog</u> in order to:

- Find out if we have a particular title and if it is currently available
- Place holds on books that are currently "out" (so they can be delivered to the classroom when they are available)
- Open and read (or reserve) **eBooks**: if there is a popular title that is often checked out and unavailable, see if we have it as an eBook and read it on your device!

eBooks and Audiobooks

Free Audiobooks: Audible is currently offering free audio books, including titles across eight different languages. There is no limit to the number of people who can listen to Audible Stories at the same time.

Use the ATES Library Catalog to access eBooks: Popular titles recently added!

Be sure to log in to gain full access: use the login button at the top left, then use the blue bar at the TOP of the screen to enter your FCPS login. Scroll down to see the "eBooks" and "Collections" banners for ebooks and other electronic resources, as well as the logins and passwords (in the "Databases and other Electronic Resources" Collection, or click here for logins and passwords and bookmark this page in your browser.)
