99% G9-12 credits earned to progress to next grade level

86% G12 succeeding in 1 or more AP/IB/DE or CTE finisher

98% G9-11 Succeeding in Honors/CTE

73% G9-12 with no marks lower than C- (up 11%)!!

Overall decrease in discipline incidents and improved in all but 1 subgroup

19.8% Chronic Absenteeism Rate (73% excused)

86% Overall Math pass rate is steady, however we have see dips in subgroups (SWD and Black) which has dropped below the expected 3 year average - to 55%
