Items the shelter is able to accept:

New or gently used:

- Fleece blankets of any size
- Bath and hand towels
- Stuffed dog and cat toys
- Collars, harnesses, leashes (please no extendable leashes)
- Collapsible dog crates
- Ceramic food bowls, small bowls for cats and small animals
- Pet beds (please no extra large beds)

New only:

- Tennis balls
- Cat carriers and scratchers
- Soft treats
- Flea/tick and heartworm preventatives
- Pee pads
- Cat litter

Items they are unable to accept:

- Bedding (including sheets, comforters, pillows, cushions, sleeping bags)
- Any damaged or heavily used, dirty or ripped/torn items
- Used plastic crates, carriers or cages
- Used litter boxes
- Dog diapers
- Homemade treats or toys
- Used cat scratchers
- Cat trees
- Prescription medications
- Pet ramps/stairs
- Retractable leashes and prong collars
- Hard treats bones, rawhide, etc.
