LATE WORK

- **Summative Assignments:** There is no late-work penalty for mastery assignments turned in within the two-week grace period.
- **Formative Assignments:** Your teacher may or may not accept late non-mastery assignments for full credit. Look at your teacher's syllabus for more information.



WEIGHTED CATEGORIES

Formative

- Assignments that are used throughout a unit to check in with your understanding before the Summative assignment.

- Assessment that measures mastery of standards.
- Assignments in this category are eligible for reassessment.
- Before your second chance, you will need to prepare based on your teacher's requirements.
- There will be no reassessment opportunity for summative assignments on which a student receives teacher feedback for improvement before the final summative submission (i.e. feedback offered to students throughout the writing process of an essay).

ROLLING GRADEBOOK

- Think of end-of-quarter report cards as quick snapshots of your learning so far. Final grades are the only ones that count towards your GPA.
- Instead of averaging each of the 4 quarter grades, rolling gradebooks are set up so the final course grade is determined by averaging of all the assignments and assessments throughout the year.

Grades are communication of student progress towards mastery of the guaranteed and viable curriculum.
