SibTeen is a place where participants will feel validated and understood and can build upon their community of support. And.... there will be food!







Sibshops may be "therapeutic" for teens to attend, but **they are not therapy**. The Sibshops model takes a wellness perspective. Sibshops is a celebration of the many lifelong contributions made by brothers and sisters of people with special health and developmental needs. Sibshops are typically offered on teacher workdays, and occasionally on Saturdays.
