<u>The Harry F. Byrd, Jr. Leadership Award</u> recognizes Virginia's high school students exhibiting excellence of character, leadership, devotion to duty, and academic accomplishment. Mission: Recognize and nurture public service, which is critical to the preservation of American democracy, by awarding Virginia's high school seniors who demonstrate a combination of excellence of character, qualities of leadership, devotion to duty and academic accomplishment with a \$25,000 award.

Each secondary school in Virginia may nominate one graduating senior. From the applicant pool, one JMHS student application will be selected and submitted to the sponsor for further consideration.
