Students should bring their Social Security Number or Permanent Resident card (if you have), a laptop and phone for this session.**

During these sessions, applicants will complete the Direct Enrollment Survey, record their results to use with choosing classes for the Fall 2025 semester and view their program of study. You will learn how to check Holds, Financial Aid checklists and who to contact for resolution and assistance (if applicable, forms will be provided to clear any holds, i.e.: under 18, dual enrollment form, in-state tuition, etc.). Lastly, participants will determine their first semester's recommended courses, be taught how to access the registration system via SIS and how to select and register for classes.
