




- Bill signed in April 2022

- FCPS goal: All students reading by third grade in 2030



Evidence-Based Literacy Instruction

What It Is	What It's Not	
Backed by research	Left to chance	
Explicit & systematic	Boring, skill & drill	
Differentiated based on skill	A one-size-fits-all approach	
Addresses multiple aspects of literacy instruction	A phonics-only approach

Fall Literacy Assessments

VALLSS	K-3
iReady Reading	Grades 3-6
Passage Reading Fluency	Grades 4-6 *as needed
Developmental Spelling Assessment	Grades 4-6
CORE Phonics	Grades 4-6 *as needed

Schoolwide Literacy Block

- Daily, beginning October 15th, for Grades 1-6
- 30-minute state-mandated literacy block occurring outside of the regular Language Arts block
- Data-driven, skills-Based groups designed to support student needs
- Explicit and systematic Instruction
- Students grouped across grade level, may be supported by another classroom teacher
- Consistent progress monitoring, for additional adjustments to groups



Lexia Learning

- Core5: K-5, PowerUp: 6th
- Adaptive blended learning model (both independent & teacher-led)
- Addresses multiple strands of literacy
- Students access program 2-5 times per week during Language Arts block
- Usage intended for school only
