### **Service Learning**

Service learning experiences involve students in authentic services to their communities. These experiences enable students to learn and apply academic, social, and personal skills to improve the community, continue individual growth, and develop a lifelong ethic of service.

**Students** must use x2VOL to get credit for their service learning hours. **Seniors** who complete 40 hours during grades 9-12 are eligible to wear a black Service Learning cord at graduation. Those hours must be logged by April 25, 2025. Students are still able to earn a diploma in the Commonwealth of Virginia without completing service hours.

If you have hours that haven't been verified in a timely manner, those hours will not be approved by Madison HS unless you take additional steps.

#### ASVAB | Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery Register by November 18 HERE



The ASVAB is required for military enlistment, but is also a career exploration program that includes an aptitude test and interest assessment to help guide you with careers and jobs that might be of interest to you.

The ASVAB will be given at Madison High School on December 4, 2024. The ASVAB test will begin at 8:30am and will take approximately 3 hours. There is no fee to take this test. Students should arrive by 8:10am to Madison HS. The ASVAB is open for students in grades 11 and 12.
