Marymount University’s Center for the Innovative Workforce is accepting applications for Cohort II from **December 2nd to January 31st**. This program is designed specifically for women who are caregivers, presently unemployed or underemployed, and interested in starting a career in IT as a Help Desk Support Technician.

### What You’ll Gain:

- A *no-cost* 12-week training program (in-person or online) on the fundamentals of IT to prepare for an entry-level IT helpdesk position
- CompTIA IT Fundamentals certification
- Support with job search strategies, resumé building, and mock interviews
- Six months of mentorship through the job search and early career

### Are You Eligible?

- Must be a woman who is a caregiver
- Hold a high school diploma/GED or international equivalent
- Legally authorized to work in the U.S
- Ready to start training in March
- Proficient in English (written & verbal), Second language proficiency is a plus
- Residing in the DMV area (DC, Maryland, or Northern Virginia) is preferred but not required

### Selection Process:

1. Submit your application.
2. Await a selection email for an interview.
3. Complete the interview process.
4. Receive final selection notification for Cohort II.

The total cost of the program is \$776,000. \$766,000 (98.7%) is funded through a U.S. Department of Labor- Community Project Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending grant. The other \$10,000 (1.3%) is funded through ISACA, a non-Federal source.
