






- The National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) is also called 'The Nation's Report Card'
 - Developed as a measure of the educational achievement and progress of students in grades 4 and 8
- In FCPS, NAEP testing was limited to 8 elementary and 13 middle schools in 2024.
 - Only 466 FCPS students (less than 2% of FCPS 4th and 8th graders) participated in NAEP testing in 2024
 - This represented just 0.25% of all enrolled FCPS students in K-12.
- FCPS does NOT receive student, school, or division results for NAEP.
 - NAEP results are reported at the state and national levels.

- FCPS does NOT receive student, school, or division results for NAEP
- NAEP was only conducted in 8 Elementary and 13 Middle Schools
- Less than 2% of FCPS 4th and 8th graders participated in the 2024 NAEP

Interpreting NAEP Results

- NAEP Proficient level represents "a solid academic performance for the given grade over challenging subject matter."
- NAEP Basic level is roughly equivalent to passing most state assessments.
- Achievement Levels are evaluated by the Commissioner of the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) to determine if the levels are reasonable, valid, and informative.
 - The last evaluation in 2016 concluded further evidence was needed.
 - The NCES Commissioner has maintained the trial status of NAEP levels at this time.
