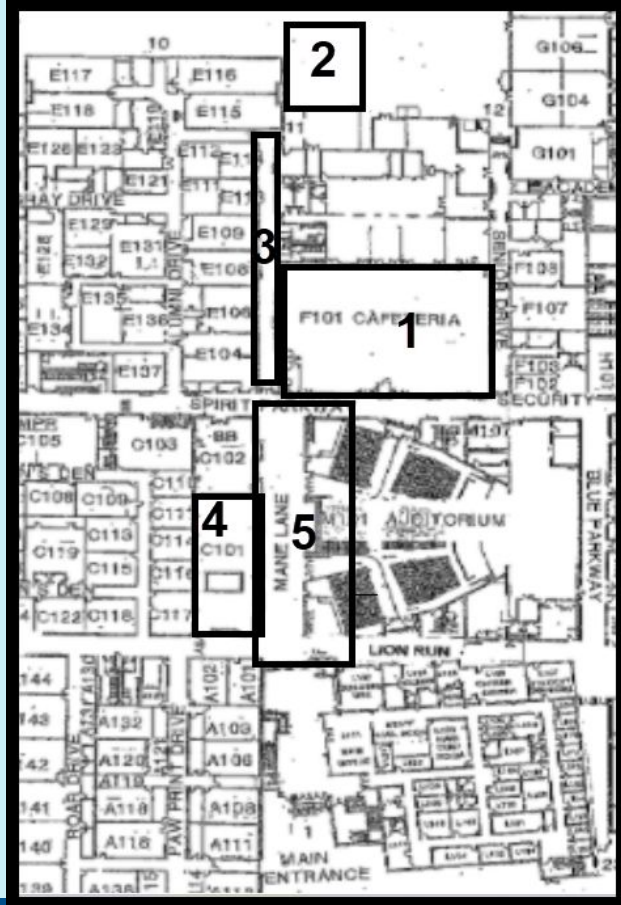
FCPS Cell Phone Policy

- **Phones and phone accessories (Airpods, earbuds, headsets, and other devices that can connect to a phone/device) must be off and away during all instructional periods.**
- **Phones and accessories must be stored in a backpack, bag, or locker.**
- **Cell phones and other mobile devices are prohibited in restrooms and locker rooms before and after school except in emergency situations.**

FCPS Cell Phone Policy

- Cell phone use is permitted only before 8:10, after 2:55, and during lunch ONLY in designated lunch areas (not in the hallways on the way to & from lunch)
- Violation of the cell phone policy will be treated as a disciplinary incident.
- Cell phones will be confiscated and students will be required to pick them up in the front office at the end of the day. After the 4th violation, they are turned in each morning for a 20 day period.

Designated Phones Zones @ Lunch



The outlined AREAS are the only places during lunch that cell phone and devices can be accessed.

1. Cafeteria
2. Savannah (Outside Door 11)
3. E/F Hallway
4. Senior Courtyard
5. Commons & Pits

Tardies

According to the SRR; Students have the responsibility to attend school regularly, on time, and follow assigned schedules.

- **Tardy consequences will include the following consequences:**
- **Revoking of parking passes for 7, 14, or to 21 days**
- **Temporary removal from clubs, teams, and team sponsored activities (7, 14, or up to 21 days)**
- **Make sure that you are here early enough so that you are not tardy to class.**

Football Game Protocols

Football Protocols 2025

- **Tickets:** Student tickets are \$5 or you can buy a YEAR-LONG LIONS PASS for \$50 – This pass will get you into every home regular season game!
- **Entry to games:** Gates will open at 6pm. If you arrive after the 3rd quarter, you will need to show a Fairfax ID.
- **Re-Entry:** No re-entry! Once you leave, you are not allowed back into the stadium.
- **Backpacks, Bags and Other Outside Items:** Students are NOT permitted to bring bags or backpacks into the stadium. All noisemakers such as whistles, air horns, and similar noise makers are strictly prohibited.
- **Food and Beverages:** NO outside food or drink are permitted inside the stadium.

Football Protocols (continued)

- **Smoking & Tobacco Use:** Smoking and the use of all tobacco products on any Fairfax County Public School campus is prohibited. This prohibition applies to all individuals while on any FCPS campus, including faculty, staff, students, administrators, and visitors. Cigarettes, e-cigarettes, smokeless tobacco, snuff, pipes, and chewing tobacco are NOT permitted.
- **Sportsmanship:** Fairfax HS students, parents, and community members are asked to demonstrate good citizenship, respect for all, and positive sportsmanship throughout the game. We cheer for Fairfax and not against our opponent. All cheers should be positive!
