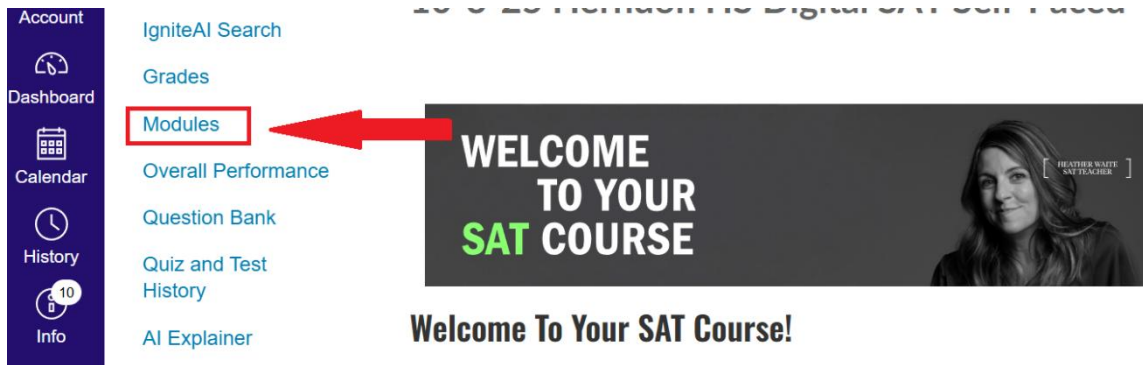

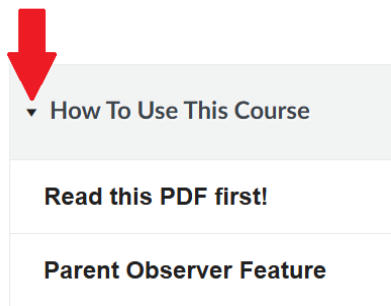

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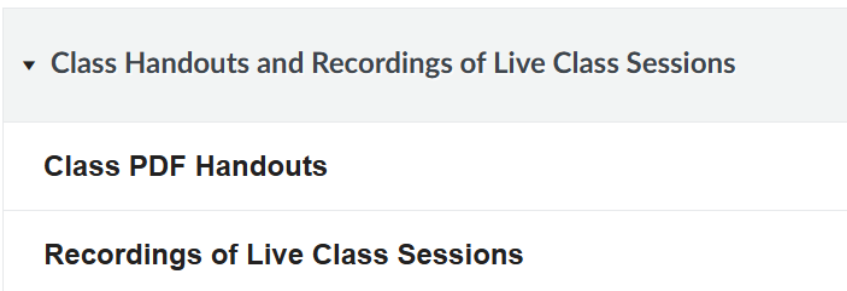
From the Home screen, click on Modules to take you to the course materials.

You can either start by watching a session's video and then supplementing your learning with the content in each module...or you can work through the content in each module and then watch the video recording to reinforce what you learned.

Each module covers various topics from the SAT. Each topic begins with a short video lesson explaining the topic and various strategies. A five-question practice (with hints and feedback) follows the video lesson. The topic concludes with a five-question quiz (with feedback) to test your understanding.

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There are four full-length SAT practice tests included in the course. Upon completion of a full-length practice test, you will be able to review all sorts of data such as the number questions correct/wrong, how you did specifically on each topic and subtopic covered, and how you did when you changed your original answer.
