



James Madison High School 2026 AP Exam Information

Exam Start Times

Students are encouraged to arrive by 7:45 a.m. for morning AP exams and by 11:45 a.m. for afternoon exams. When students arrive in the testing room, they will need to check in for their assigned seat location. Directions will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. After directions have been read, no students will be permitted to enter the testing room. There are no make-up (late) exams unless there is a serious medical reason which must meet requirements set by The College Board. Students may not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended and should not ask to leave early before they are dismissed. **Afternoon exams may finish as late as 4:30 or 5pm., have a ride home planned, if necessary.** Your students will not have access to their phones during the exam to update finish times. AP teachers can advise students on specific exam timing. Students should plan for their own transportation if they have an afternoon exam. If students are in a spring sport or have a job, it is their responsibility to inform their coach or employer of their AP Exam obligation and make arrangements accordingly.

What to Bring on the day of your AP Exam

- ✓ Fully charged Chromebook- students must test on an FCPS device. A limited number of loaner computers will be available on test day for students without an FCPS Chromebook.
- ✓ Chromebook chargers (no loaner chargers will be available)
- ✓ Students **must know their College Board login information** on the day of their exam. Students will be accessing the exam through the Bluebook Application through kiosk mode and will not be able to retrieve a saved username and password.
- ✓ Black or dark blue pens for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions for hybrid exams
- ✓ Calculator: For all exams that allow or require calculators, you can use the built-in Desmos graphing calculator through the Bluebook testing application. Note that for Calculus AB, Calculus BC, and Precalculus, Desmos will only be available in the calculator-required parts of the exam. These exams continue to have parts where no calculator is allowed. - ✓ Bring layers! The temperature varies in different testing locations and some locations can be very cold.

Do NOT bring to the exam...

Electronic devices of ANY kind (including phones, smartwatches, wearable technology), bag/backpacks/purses, books, dictionaries, notes, rulers or straightedges (except as noted), compasses, scratch paper, a watch with an alarm, photographic equipment, computers or calculators (except as noted), correction fluid/tape, highlighters, colored pencils, food or drinks (except in the break area), ear plugs, or clothing with subject-related information.

Snacks

Students may bring a small snack to be eaten during the 10-minute break. Snacks should be placed in a clear Ziploc style bag. No lunch boxes/bags are permitted.

Lunch

Students taking an afternoon (PM) exam should eat "A" lunch that day.

Students taking a morning exam will attend their normally scheduled class lunch period unless it has been missed due to the AP exam. If that happens, students will go to lunch first.

Attendance

Students will be expected to attend their regularly scheduled classes either before or after their exam unless they have completed the [AP Attendance Form](#).

- Mark your home and personal calendars to reflect your AP Exam date(s) and time(s).
