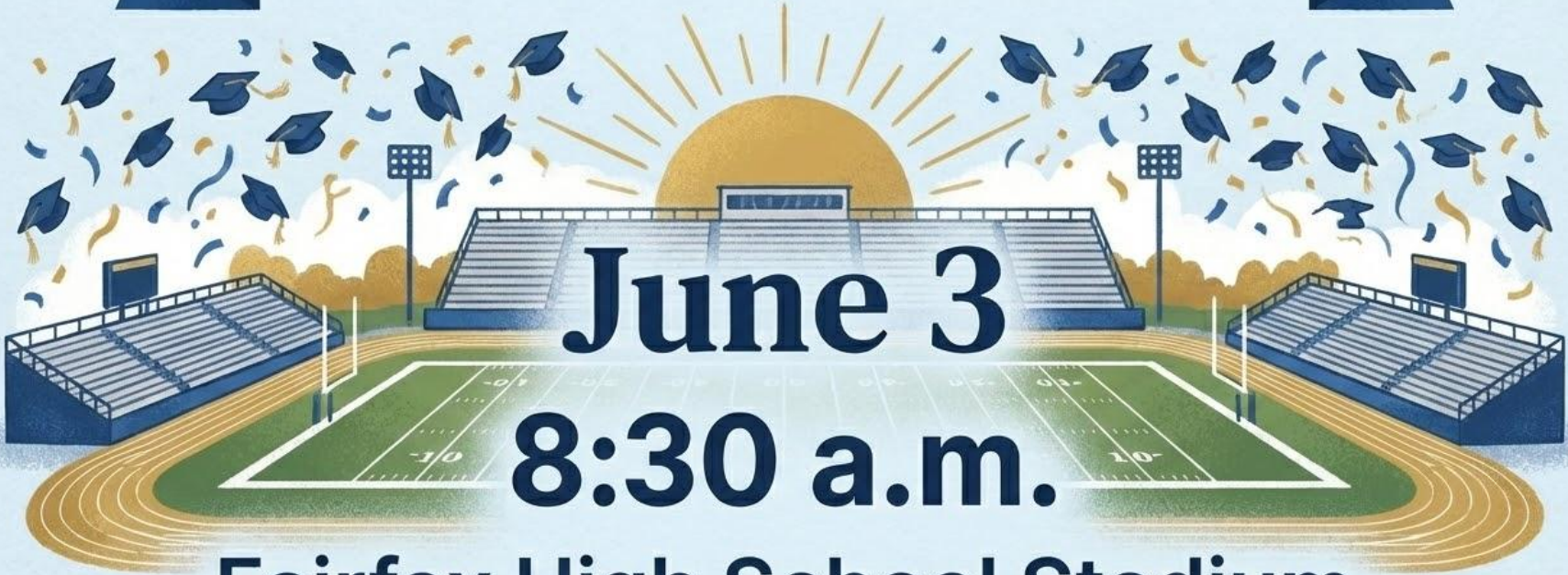

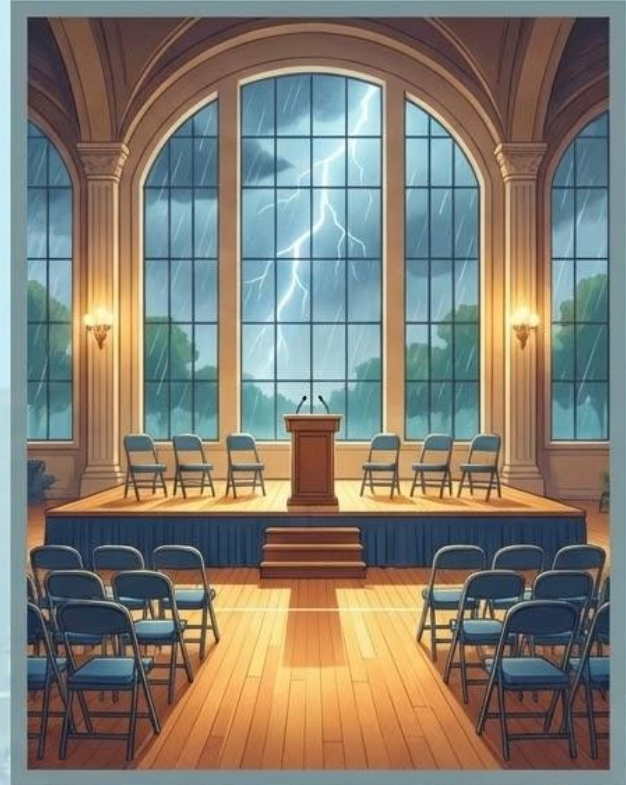

Caps not meeting guidelines will be replaced

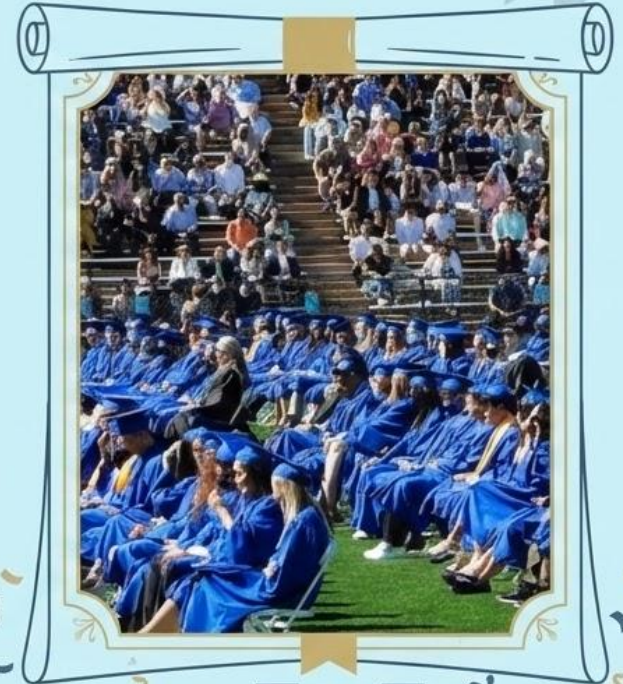

Early College Scholars

The Early College Scholars program allows eligible public high school students to earn a minimum of 15 transferable college credits while fulfilling the requirements for an Advanced Studies Diploma. For the first time this form is now available in the [Parent Digital Consent](#) portal which you can access with the same username and password as [ParentVue](#). Please take a moment to login and opt in for this program.

To qualify for this program, you'll need to meet these criteria:

- Maintain a "B" average or better in your high school courses; and
- Be pursuing an Advanced Studies Diploma; and
- Successfully complete college-level coursework, such as AP, International Baccalaureate, Cambridge, or dual enrollment, to earn at least 15 transferable* college credits. * *the actual number of transferable college credits awarded depends on the criteria of the admitting college or university.*

To formalize your participation, you'll sign an [Governor's Early College Scholars Agreement](#), which will also be signed by your parents or guardians, principal, and school counselor.

Parents can complete the form in the [Parent Digital Consent](#) portal or a hard copy of the form can be returned to your student's school counselor in Student Services.

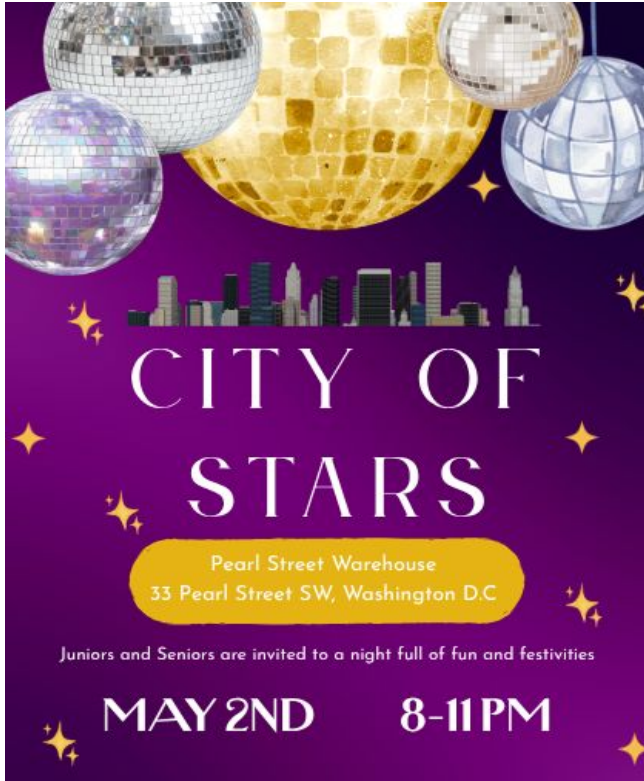

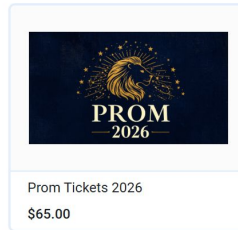
