Goals and Purpose

Plans of Safe Care involve an interdisciplinary approach to providing support during and after pregnancy to mothers and their babies who are at risk of substance use and substance exposure. This is an active learning opportunity regarding Washington's initiative to support families. Participants will receive an overview of Washington's need and current efforts, examples of successful models from other states, and the strategy for rolling out Plans of Safe Care in Washington. This model is designed to take a highly collaborative, proactive and preventive approach to help keep families together and healthy. Participants will take part in dialogue and visioning activities for Plans of Safe Care in Washington.

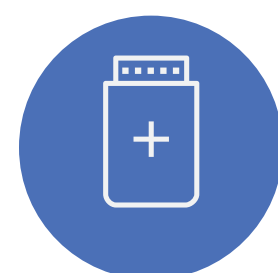
