Rental & Utility Assistance

Chief Seattle Club has received new grant funding to support families & individuals with past due rental arrears. Relatives who have been impacted by Covid-19 may apply for rental & utility assistance.

What you will need...

- √ 1. Past due rental statement or ledger balance, past due utility bills.
- ✓ 2. Copy of Lease agreement.
- ✓ 3. Proof of Income (unemployment, wages, benefits award letter).
- √ 4. Tribal ID NOT required.

Eligibility Requirements:


- Head of Household must be listed on lease agreement.
- ✓ 2. Combined household income (all adults +18) under 80% of Area Median Income.
- ✓ 3. Must reside within Washington state.
- √ 4. Landlord/Leasing company must provide Tax ID
