We are seeking 20 young adults to join a new program called the Collaborative Learning Lab (CLL). The CLL is a group of young adults who have experienced foster care, Treehouse staff and university researchers who will engage in community building, collaborative learning and decision making. CLL group members will help Treehouse better understand how to partner with young adults to improve the education and child welfare systems.

Who can join?

- Any young adult (ages 18-25) who has experienced DCYF, federal or tribal foster care in Washington state.
- You do NOT have to have had any Treehouse engagement.
- We encourage participation from the following communities: LGBTQIA, BIPOC, immigrants and refugees, parents, English language learners, tribal members.

When does the lab meet?

- Meetings are 1.5 hours twice a month from February to June 2022.
- Meetings are online using Zoom.
- We will work with you to accommodate schedules and capacity.
