Washington Early Childhood Statistics

- 827K Children Under 9 YO
- 12% Kids living in Poverty (6 Percentage Point Decrease from 2010)
- 24% Parents Lack Secure Employment (8 Percentage Point Decrease)
- 6.4% Low Birth-weight Babies
- 3% Children Without Health Insurance
- 54% 3 & 4 YO Not in School (5 Percentage Point Decrease)
- 65% 4th Graders Not Proficient in Reading

Bright by Text Goals

- Build parent and caregiver competence, confidence, and connection, prenatally through early childhood (through age 9).
- 2. Increase parent and caregiver **engagement** with their children.
- Improve parent and caregiver access to and connection with trusted information and state and local resources.
- 3. IMPROVE CHILD OUTCOMES.


