About our Conference

Presenter Honorarium

Cohorts: Lead presenters of each cohort will receive an honorarium. Lead presenters will receive \$1,200 for three 1.5-hour sessions and a complimentary full-conference registration. Co-presenters will receive complimentary full-conference registration. There can be up to two additional co-presenters for each session.

Single Sessions: Lead presenters of each session will receive an honorarium. Lead presenters who are Child Care Aware field staff will receive \$300, and other lead presenters not associated with CCA will receive \$400. Complimentary full-conference registration will be available to all presenters. There can be up to two additional co-presenters for each session.

- How would you frame your session content in alignment with our theme?
