Incident: Green Hill Staff Members Charged with Official Misconduct

In November, Detectives with the Chehalis Police Department received information that a staff member at Green Hill School may have been having an inappropriate relationship with a resident. After reviewing social media and cell phone records, Detectives discovered evidence that the suspect, Charity R. Johnson, a 37-year-old Winlock resident, sent sexually suggestive photographs of herself and had lengthy phone conversations with a resident who had a contraband cell phone in his possession. Additionally, those records also indicate Johnson had received money in exchange for agreeing to bring illegal contraband into the facility.

Johnson was booked into the Lewis County Jail on December 11, 2024, for RCW 9A.080.010 Official Misconduct and RCW 9A.76.175 Making a False Statement to a Public Servant. She is also being referred for RCW 9A.28.040.E Criminal Conspiracy.

In a separate case, Chehalis Detectives learned that another staff member may have been having an inappropriate relationship with a resident at Green Hill School. After a review of social media and cell phone records, Detectives discovered evidence that the suspect, Alexa Rain, a 26-year-old Longview resident, sent sexually suggestive photographs of herself and had lengthy text message conversations with a resident through a contraband cell phone in his possession.

After several attempts to contact Rain failed, she was referred for RCW 9A.80.010 Official Misconduct.

The Chehalis Police Department is also currently investigating four separate cases of suspected resident drug overdoses which occurred between December 5, 2024, and December 8, 2024, at Green Hill School. No deaths or long-term hospitalizations were reported. Since these cases are currently active, no further information is being released at this time.

The Chehalis Police Department will continue to aggressively investigate those who are involved in criminal activity at Green Hill School.
