Washington FACE Program

Goal: Prevent Work-Related Fatal Injuries

- 1) Track all work-related injury fatalities.
- 2) <u>Investigate</u> select fatal incidents to determine incident factors and prevention recommendations.
- 3) <u>Develop and communicate</u> reports and other prevention resources to those who can intervene in the workplace to prevent similar fatal and nonfatal work-related injuries.





How do we compare?

Worker Fatality Rate per 100,000 FTE in 2021


	All industries	Construction

CA	2.8	6.3
OR	3.3	6.0
US	3.6	9.4

Worker Fatality Rates in Top 3 WA Industries



Worker Fatalities by Top 5 Industries, 2023


