

Morning Case Update

COVID-19 surveillance data are dynamically stored in the Washington Disease Reporting System (WDRS). The data are updated when new information about a case is entered, such as exposure information, change in address, lab data from diagnostic and routine tests, date of death, case information from medical providers, or information from other jurisdictions indicating a person has moved out of Washington. Given the dynamic nature of COVID-19 surveillance data, data reported in the past may not match data reported in present time.

The data in this report are reflective of all cases received as of 11:59 PM 01/23/2021.

Notice:

Sunday, January 24, 2021: Due to delays in negative laboratory test result processing this morning, testing data by county is only available for New Positive Tests.

Sunday, January 24, 2021: Total case counts may include up to 800 duplicates. As a reminder, all data in the epi reports are incomplete and should be interpreted with caution. Wednesday December 16, 2020: The daily epi report was revised to more comprehensively include COVID-19 cases with a positive antigen test in alignment with how data are presented on the dashboards. Cases with a positive antigen test, called probable cases, are included in case, hospitalization, and death counts. Probable cases since June 2020, when they were first reported in Washington, are included. Testing data are limited to molecular testing and do not include antigens.

Wednesday December 16, 2020: We are replacing the term “PCR” with “molecular” in this report. This specific change only refers to the language used and does not change the way the data are presented. Molecular tests include but are not limited to PCR tests, therefore we are transitioning to using the more inclusive term “molecular.” It is important to note that molecular tests are different than antigen tests.

Death counts are no longer updated over the weekend. All death numbers are as reported Friday.

Case Definitions

Confirmed cases are those individuals with a positive molecular test, including PCR.

Probable cases are those individuals with a positive antigen test and no positive molecular test.

Molecular Testing Data by County

The following table shows the number of new positive and negative molecular tests for each county and the state. New tests are defined by an investigation create date of the previous day (2021-01-23). The 7 day average of new molecular tests includes tests with investigation create dates from 2021-01-16 to 2021-01-23. Note that the data included here are summarized by investigation create date, which is different than what we publish on the dashboards. The dashboards summarize molecular testing data by specimen collection date, which is more biologically meaningful, but has a lag time and is only 90% complete by 10 days after the specimen collection date.
