Subject: Upcoming Vacancies for Advanced Social Worker and Public Member

The Department of Health (department) is recruiting to fill an upcoming professional vacancy as well as a public member vacancy on the Washington State Mental Health Counselors, Marriage and Family Therapists, and Social Workers Advisory Committee. The committee provides advice to the secretary of health (secretary) on issues related to licensees' practice. The secretary appoints all members.

Current vacancies on the committee:

- One advanced social worker (there will be a vacancy as of October 2022)
- One public member (there is an immediate vacancy)

Applicant eligibility:

- Must be resident of Washington state.
- hold an office in a professional association for mental health, social work, or marriage and family therapy.
- May not be employed by Washington State.
- Must have worked as a licensee for five years.
- Public members represent the public and [may not be affiliated with the professions listed in RCW 18.225](#).

Meetings

The committee meets four times a year at the Department of Health offices in Tumwater. However, during the pandemic, all meetings have been conducted online and will continue until the governor has lifted the emergency proclamation. When in-person meetings resume, committee members will be reimbursed for travel expenses. In addition, members are compensated \$50 per day for attending a meeting.
